GOOD DEWS

The word gospel means "good news."

To know why the news is so good, you must first hear the bad news. God's Word teaches that, since Adam's original rebellion, everyone is born a sinner. The price of sin is physical, spiritual and eternal death away from the presence of God. The Bible also teaches we cannot save ourselves through personal improvement or good deeds. We need more than God's help, in fact. We need God to do it all for us.

The good news is that "God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him." (John 3:16–17). That's right, Jesus lived a sinless life for us and then suffered the punishment due for our sin. He purchased our salvation through the cross and empty tomb.

What God requires of you to be saved? Jesus said, "repent and believe the good news" (Mar 1:15). Confess your sin to him, then place your faith & trust in Jesus as the only Savior for all people (Romans 10:9; 1 Timothy 4:10). When you do, the Holy Spirit will apply the saving work of Christ to you personally. You'll have spiritual and eternal life because He will come to dwell in you forever. God promises that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord WILL be saved (Romans 10:13).
