Gratitude and a mother's spirit fill the French Family Lounge

In 2007, the children of the late Mary Lou and James French made a generous gift to renovate the French Family Lounge in the women's health area at Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center. This was the third time in the past two decades that the French family has stepped forward to furnish and later refurbish the lounge area. Their latest gift helped create a lovely new, expanded space, perfect for parents and family members to gather after the birth of a child.

Origins of this story date back to 1968 when James and Mary Lou French began the J. L. French Corporation in Sheboygan, with only a handful of employees. Thanks to the hard work and vision of its founders and its employees, the company enjoyed steady growth and achieved national recognition for manufacturing high-quality automotive assemblies.

By 1996, the company's ranks had grown to more than 600 employees and the J. L. French Corporation was sold. Today, the company is known as J. L. French Automotive Castings, a manufacturer of die cast aluminum components and assemblies.

The French family's initial gift to the hospital was made almost 20 years ago. It was a time when all four of the French children were working at the J. L. French Corporation in Sheboygan. Since that time, David French has moved to San Diego, Jeanna French relocated to Phoenix, Paula French Van Akkeren lives in Denver, while Brian French still resides in the Sheboygan area.

In the spring of 1989, the French children wanted to do something memorable for their mother in honor of Mother's Day. They wanted a special gift that reflected their deep love and gratitude to their mom whom they describe as being a kind, gracious, generous, fun and compassionate person.

Daughter and family spokesperson Jeanna French said, "We looked for a unique way to show our mother how incredibly special she was to the four of us. That first gift to furnish the Family Lounge at the hospital in her honor was the perfect gift. Not only did the gift fit our desires, it also reflected my mother's life beautifully."

According to her children, community service was always a big part of Mary Lou's life. She gave her time and talents to many Sheboygan-area organizations. Whether it was delivering a hot meal or helping out at the blood bank, her giving spirit touched many lives. Mary Lou would later be the major influence in establishing the philanthropic J. L. French Family Foundation. Gifts from this foundation have helped various community-minded organizations

throughout the years, including the YMCA, Mead Public Library, Safe Harbor and the Aurora Health Foundation.

Jeanna explained why the French children knew that a gift to the hospital was a fitting way to honor their mother. She said, "After my parents were married and my father was in the service, they moved to El Paso, Texas. My mom worked as a delivery room nurse at a local hospital. Her entire Spanish vocabulary consisted of phrases such as 'Empuje! No empuje!' (Push! Don't push!) 'Tome las respiraciones profundas.' (Take deep breaths.) 'Es un muchacho! Es una muchacha!' (It's a boy! It's a girl!) Being surrounded by the miracle of childbirth touched her spirit and sparked her lifelong journey advocating for women and children.

"As part of her community service, our mom served on the LifeStream board at Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center in the late 1980s, providing both personal and financial support for programs that benefited women and children. We knew that a gift to the same department where her own nursing career began many years before was perfect, since she was so personally involved with the hospital at that time."

Jeanna went on to say, "Our first gift was given in the spring of 1989. Little did we know that by the time the room would need updating some years later, our mom would no longer be with us. She passed away in 1995 at the age of 64. But our memories of that special day, when our family first gathered in the new Family Lounge to celebrate our mother's life, are still a source of joy."

"We were so glad we had the opportunity to make this donation while our mother was still alive," Jeanna said. "It gave us the great pleasure of witnessing and remembering

her wonderful smile that day. Giving a donation to honor someone while they are living is a much richer experience for all parties involved."

Jeanna added, "Last year our family was approached because the French Family Lounge needed renovating once again. The hospital wanted to move the lounge to a larger space, as part of a facility renovation. All four of us were proud to make another donation to honor our mother's memory and her commitment to

the health and wellness of women and children. While it's been 13 years since our mother passed away, the memory of her warm, compassionate spirit still lingers in our hearts."

Commenting on this generous gift to Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center, Bobbe Teigen, chief administrative officer of the hospital, said, "We want to express our sincere appreciation to the French Family. They can be assured that the renovated space has provided a wonderful place for families to gather and celebrate in our women's health department."

A beautifully worded plaque hangs in the French Family Lounge bearing a photo of the late Mary Lou French with an inscription honoring her memory. The touching tribute on the plaque resonates as loudly today as it did back in 1989 — when four loving children gathered to honor their beloved mother in a special way. It reads:

"This room is dedicated with lasting gratitude and in loving memory of Mary Lou French, by her children as a symbol of their mother's love for her family, friends and community. May those who visit here be graced with calmness, hope and renewed strength."

Aurora Medical Center nurse makes plans to support the profession she loves

Aurora Medical Center in Oshkosh obstetrical nurse Jenny Ahlers has been contemplating what to do with her estate. This requires introspection, planning and foresight. Although she’s barely approaching middle age, Jenny recently arranged to make a planned gift to benefit the Aurora Health Foundation and support a nursing scholarship for an employee or family member at Aurora Medical Center in Oshkosh.

“I’m single and don’t have children to leave my assets to,” Jenny explained. “I’ve been in nursing my entire career and wanted to find a way to support the profession long after I’m gone. Nursing means a lot to me.” Jenny has served as an obstetrical nurse for more than 20 years. She joined Aurora Medical Center when the hospital opened in the fall of 2003. While some long-time nurses may complain of “burn out” and job dissatisfaction, Jenny remains happy to be working in her chosen profession. She proudly explains, “I love what I do.”

Working in health care and growing up on a farm helped Jenny develop a realistic approach to life and death. “Death is part of life,” she said. “We learned that life lesson at an early age growing up on a farm and seeing the life-cycle of animals. Our family didn’t shy away from the topic of death.”

Jenny credits both of her parents for instilling a strong work ethic in her. She said, “My dad ran a pig farm near Redgranite and also held a regular full-time job. He worked hard every day as a foreman in a foundry and then came home to work on the farm. He wasn’t highly educated, but he certainly was intelligent and understood the value of a dollar. My mom attended Marquette University in Milwaukee and worked as a nurse for many years.

Jenny added, “Both of my parents died before reaching their 65th birthday. None of us know how long we’ll be here, so we all need to plan ahead.” As for planning ahead, Jenny wanted to be the one who would decide where her money would go after she’s gone. She drew inspiration for her estate planning from her love of nursing.

From a young age, Jenny dreamed of becoming a nurse. “I always knew that’s what I wanted to be, even though some of the nursing coursework was challenging for me,” she recalled. Jenny attended Lakeland College in Sheboygan County and the former Deaconess School of Nursing in Milwaukee. She earned her registered nurse diploma in the early 1980s. Since Jenny wasn’t at the top of her class, she wasn’t eligible for most nursing school scholarships.

Jenny explains, “I want this new scholarship at the Aurora Health Foundation to help others achieve their dream of becoming nurses. Applicants won’t have to be at the top of their class, and needn’t be traditional-

age students, just dedicated to the nursing field. Applicants will need to be accepted into an accredited nursing program. Once selected to receive the scholarship, they can use the funds to pay tuition, help with books, put food on the table — *whatever it takes to help them complete their education*. The main criterion is to have a real passion for nursing.”

Lynn Kleman, Senior Philanthropy Officer of the Aurora Health Foundation, helped Jenny set up this scholarship. Lynn said, “Jenny’s personal story serves as an inspiration for others. She’s not the CEO of a Fortune 500 company having a multi-million dollar estate to bequeath. Jenny is an average, hardworking nurse who’s dedicated her life to serving others. She took the initiative to plan ahead so that a percentage of her estate can go into a fund restricted to support a cause she personally believes in.”

Lynn added, “It’s never too early to start thinking about leaving a legacy that will help others, as well as giving the donor peace of mind. Jenny can be secure in the knowledge that her gift will impact the lives of future nurses and the nursing profession for many years to come. And because of her foresight and generosity, we at the Foundation are most grateful.”

Quiet leadership and a personal touch help guide community involvement

Whether working with her investment clients or donating time to worthy non-profit organizations, Roberta Filicky-Peneski undertakes the task at hand with quiet leadership and a warm, personal touch.

Roberta became involved with the Aurora Health Foundation in 2000, when the Aurora Visiting Nurse Association (VNA) of Wisconsin joined forces with the Foundation to coordinate fundraising and philanthropic endeavors throughout Aurora's central region.

Since that time, she's been actively involved with the Foundation, having served on the Planned Giving Council and the Foundation's board of directors as the "voice" of the Aurora VNA.

Roberta's first connection with the VNA dates back to the 1980s when her former public relations and marketing firm helped establish a foundation to support the Sheboygan VNA (years before it became part of Aurora VNA). She later joined the Sheboygan VNA's board, and her association with the organization continued through many affiliations and name changes culminating as board chairperson for the organization now known as Aurora VNA of Wisconsin.

Her warm, personal demeanor is most evident as an Aurora VNA board member. She initiated a tradition for board members to call and personally thank all first-time donors, no matter what their level of contribution. She said, "It gave us a chance to get out of the 'board room mentality' and

to hear firsthand how people's lives were truly touched by Aurora VNA services. Health care today is such a balance between high-tech and high touch needs. For many of our patients, the gizmos only go so far. You need the high touch, too ... someone to hold your hand. That's what the Aurora VNA does so well."

In her "day" job, Roberta serves as a senior investment consultant for Robert W. Baird & Co., Inc. in downtown Sheboygan. Roberta's leadership and personalized approach shows through in her day-to-day interactions with clients. She considers herself to be a "trust builder." Roberta offers comprehensive financial planning to help clients grow their portfolios through asset allocation, diversification, portfolio management and retirement and estate planning.

Roberta said, "My philosophy is to work in partnership with clients to help them establish a long-term, disciplined

investment plan. By being a careful steward of others' assets, I believe I can indirectly help others practice life-long philanthropy. That gives me a great deal of satisfaction."

Roberta's generous, community-minded spirit was recognized in 2000 when she received Robert W. Baird's Brent Ruppel Citizenship Award for Community Service. Named after Baird's former chairman of the board, this award reflects Baird's philosophy of putting other people first. It is annually presented to one employee out of approximately 2,500. Roberta was honored for 195 years of cumulative board service in the areas of health care, women's issues, education and economic development and for her many contributions as a role model and spokesperson in the community.

The organization relies heavily on community support to fulfill its mission. Gifts of all sizes are truly appreciated and welcome."

Jeanne Kobuszewski, executive director of the Aurora Health Foundation, described Roberta's impact on the Foundation and the community. "If there ever was a role model of a dedicated, engaged board member, it would be Roberta. For years the Foundation has relied on her quiet leadership to help guide our organization, while faithfully representing the interests of Aurora VNA. We're most grateful for her unselfish and dedicated involvement in our community."

Aurora VNA – A year in review

During 2007, the Aurora Visiting Nurse Association of Wisconsin reached out to touch thousands of lives in eastern Wisconsin through hospice care, the adult day center, mobile meals and general home care services thanks to support from friends like you. The following statistics show how your support makes a dramatic difference in the lives of our families, friends and the community at large.

- Flu shots given: 80,407
- Home care patients seen: 11,001
- Patients who used home medical equipment: 26,206
- Pieces of equipment supplied: 56,980
- Personal Emergency Response Unit clients: 2,289
- Mobile meals delivered: 403,110
- In-home monitoring patients seen: 1,269

Philanthropy supports Sheboygan's greatest health care needs

Aurora Health Care began as a not-for-profit system in 1984. This means that all revenues after expenses are reinvested back into fulfilling our mission. Every dollar is spent on improving health care in the communities we serve.

Unfortunately, patient and insurance revenues do not cover the entire cost of new technology, facility improvements and all of the high-tech services needed to diagnose and treat illness. Philanthropic gifts must make up the difference.

Aurora Health Foundation donors have the option of directing their gifts toward specific funds or programs they wish to support. However, many donors prefer to direct their donations to the "Greatest Need Fund" so their gift can be used wherever it's needed most. In the Sheboygan area, we're pleased to report that many health care enhancements were financed in the past year from the Greatest Need Fund.

Here are some examples of your dollars at work in the Sheboygan community:

Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center renovations

During 2007, extensive renovations took place at Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center, including a \$200,000 project to upgrade the patient rooms and common areas in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and the cardiovascular area on the third floor.

Richard Miller, Aurora's regional director of facilities, said, "This was an extensive renovation. We replaced floor and wall coverings and added new flat-

screen televisions in every patient room. The rooms were also upgraded with new furniture and window valances. The common areas were also improved by adding new lighting and carpeting, creating a warm, more 'homelike' atmosphere."

Chief administrative officer of Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center Bobbe Teigen added, "We are delighted to offer Sheboygan-area residents a renovated health care facility. It's comforting to know that your hometown hospital is staying on par with larger medical centers by adding patient-centered amenities to our already fine facility. We are especially grateful to the Aurora Health Foundation donors who have helped make these upgrades possible."

Aurora Sheboygan Clinic receives new high-tech equipment

At Aurora Sheboygan Clinic, the Greatest Need Fund financed several expensive pieces of equipment in 2007:

- stereotactic equipment for breast biopsies
- ultrasound equipment to monitor pregnancies
- a hysteroscope to perform gynecology procedures

Stereotactic equipment: This new, state-of-the-art equipment is used to perform

breast biopsies in an outpatient setting at Aurora Sheboygan Clinic. This minimally invasive procedure is highly accurate for targeting growths for biopsy and analysis. During a stereotactic biopsy, the breast is immobilized and a small area is numbed with a local anesthetic. Then, a small nick is made in the skin, through which a needle is inserted. A computer calculates the exact position of the abnormality. Digital x-ray technology is used to guide the needle to the biopsy area so tissue samples can be taken. The process allows physicians to identify, biopsy and diagnose lumps in the breast much quicker than in the past and with less discomfort for the patient.

Chris Larson, R.N., clinic manager at Aurora Sheboygan Clinic said, "This new equipment is definitely an upgrade to our previous equipment that was 14 years old and no longer repairable or supported by the vendor. This new stereotactic equipment provides the most minimally invasive way to do breast biopsies."

Ultrasound equipment: Ultrasounds are performed to analyze a developing fetus and to view how a pregnancy is progressing. Checking for certain abnormalities such as Down's syndrome with ultrasound is important, especially in high-risk pregnancies and for mothers at increased risk of chromosomal disorders.

Dr. David Dielentheis, the OB-GYN department coordinator for ultrasound services at Aurora Sheboygan Clinic said, "Advances in technology have enabled obstetricians to minimize the risks associated with diagnosing many serious chromosomal abnormalities and congenital anomalies using ultrasound and blood testing – procedures which previously required amniocentesis or chorionic villus testing. This testing, called First Trimester Screening or Nuchal Translucency screening, has allowed the extension of this type of testing to all mothers regardless of age, while at the same time, eliminating the risk of pregnancy loss from more invasive procedures.

"The new equipment allows for highly detailed and definitive views, enhancing the medical staff's capacity to identify

potential syndromes over 90% of the time, an excellent rate of accuracy for a quick, safe, non-invasive procedure. The IU-22 ultrasound equipment also enables state-of-the-art 3D and 4D imaging of babies. Obstetricians at the Aurora Sheboygan Clinic are committed to providing the most advanced obstetrical ultrasound services in the area."

This new equipment provides the only service of its kind in Sheboygan County. Previously, patients had to drive to Milwaukee or Green Bay for this testing. Purchasing this ultrasound equipment demonstrates Aurora's commitment to enhancing the delivery of care to the patients it serves.

Hysteroscope: This is a small telescope equipped with various tools used to see inside the uterus and perform procedures such as:

- tubal ligation
- polyp and fibroid removal
- hysterectomy

Using a hysteroscope can be cost effective. It can be used to do many procedures in an office setting rather than in a hospital. Dr. David Dielentheis, a physician in the OB-GYN department at Aurora Sheboygan Clinic, said, "Patients today are much more informed and empowered about their health care. They realize the benefits of having procedures done in an office setting and avoiding general anesthesia, whenever possible. Using a hysteroscope makes uterine procedures less invasive with quicker recovery times. The risk of infection and complications is also lowered, as compared to general anesthesia procedures. The OB-GYN physicians strive to remain at the "cutting edge" of medical care by offering these procedures to the women of Sheboygan and surrounding counties."

The new equipment, along with the facility upgrades at Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center, are enhancing patient comfort and the level of health care available in the Sheboygan area. Aurora Health Foundation supporters can be assured that when their gifts are directed to the Greatest Need Fund, they are actively improving health care — right in their own community.

Sheboygan Golfing for Charities

event marks milestone 5th anniversary

Anniversaries are appropriate times to celebrate the past and look toward the future. The 5th anniversary of the Sheboygan Golfing for Charities event, held in August 2007, was a perfect time to reflect on the event’s origins and to celebrate its many accomplishments during the past five years.

Enthusiastic golfers and supporters of Aurora Health Foundation have gathered each summer at The Bull in Sheboygan Falls to raise funds to support Aurora’s cancer services in the Sheboygan area. This well attended event has repeatedly exceeded all expectations, generating gross revenues of more than \$450,000 in just five years.

Aurora Health Foundation board member Reed Schmitt, the creator of the event, has graciously served as event chairman since the outing began. Reed recalled how the idea for the first event came about. He said, “I had been on the Foundation’s board for several years when we looked at various ideas for a new fundraiser. I thought that a golf outing could combine my personal passion for golf, while generating funds for a most worthwhile cause.”

Reed freely admits to having a very personal interest in raising funds for cancer care in the Sheboygan area. His father passed away from cancer more than 20 years ago. “At that time, we had very few cancer services in this area,” Reed recalled. “The day after my dad died of cancer, ground was broken for what is now the Vince Lombardi Cancer Clinic in Sheboygan. It seemed like a sign that I should become actively involved in the fight against cancer – in some shape or form.”

Reed’s interest in improving local cancer care became heightened when

his wife Terri was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2003. He said, “She was very appreciative of the wonderful care she received from Aurora physicians and support staff in this community. Together, we believe it’s our mission to help provide these medical professionals with the necessary tools to do their jobs, which ultimately benefits us all. That’s why the annual Sheboygan Golfing for Charities event holds special significance for me.”

In the past five years, monies generated by this fundraiser have been put to good use. Proceeds have purchased capital equipment now used to improve the patient-centered care that Aurora offers cancer patients. Initiatives approved for funding by Aurora Health Foundation thus far include:

- Blanket warmers that give radiation and medical oncology patients more comfort with the changing seasons and change of temperature within the treatment area.
- Ready access to a radiation ablation machine enabling patients to receive this treatment in Sheboygan instead of having to travel out of the area.
- Adjustable exam tables that help cancer patients on and off the table with less movement and, therefore, less pain.

- Pro Focus with 3D Colorectal/Seed Implant Ultrasound equipment for use by the urology department at the Aurora Sheboygan Clinic for prostate screening and biopsies, while the surgery department will be able to use the equipment for colorectal cancer screenings.

Looking ahead, Reed has some ambitious aspirations for the 2008 Golfing for Charities event. He said, “The goal for 2008 is to once again have a full field of golfers, beautiful weather, and to raise at least \$100,000, after expenses.”

Executive director Jeanne Kobuszewski said, “We are particularly grateful to Reed Schmitt who’s been the driving force behind the Sheboygan Golfing for Charities event since its inception. Central Region *Highlights*

In 2007, Aurora Health Care made huge strides in quality and safety for our patients, highlighted by some national recognitions for our efforts. Those acknowledgments included: Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center received the *CareScience Select Practice National Quality Award* from Premier, the recognized leader in America for quality measurement. Premier evaluated more than 4,700 hospitals. Aurora Sheboygan Memorial also participated in the Premier clinical performance project and was recognized as one of the top three in three areas: obstetrics, heart failure and orthopedics. This is an incredible example of the focus and dedication of our patient care teams.

Aurora also added several new technologies in the central region to raise the quality of care for our patients. This technology included digital mammography, as well as new MRI capabilities.

Our commitment to providing the right care in the right place at the right time was confirmed in Plymouth with the openings of the new Aurora Health Center and the new Aurora Surgery Center. These state-of-the-art facilities offer services to the area never previously offered to the Plymouth community.

We also welcomed several new physicians to our area, adding to our array of medical specialties. Our medical staff offers expertise typically found in large urban settings right here in our region.

Aurora caregivers (a term used to describe *all* Aurora employees) in the central region also demonstrated their caring and generosity by giving significantly to our Aurora Partnership Campaign. In 2007, they gave a record amount. I believe this giving is in recognition of not just their responsibility to our communities, but seeing the tremendous need on a day-to-day basis, as well as the wonderful work being done by their Aurora peers.

With the financial shortfalls and increasing unfunded mandates, monies donated to Aurora Health Care are needed more than ever. Wisconsin has not increased its payments to Medicaid in over 12 years. Currently, Medicaid only pays 48 percent of our cost (not charges) so support for underfunded programs and services for critically ill patients is very helpful.

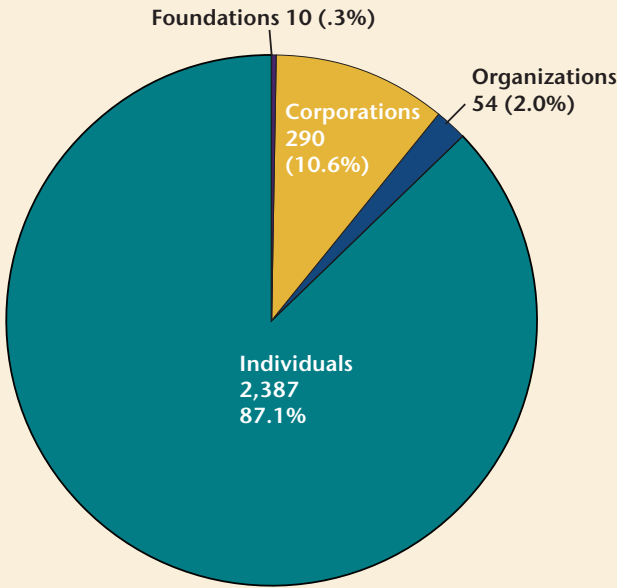
North Region *Highlights*

The ways that Aurora Health Care impacts the health and wellness of families throughout northeastern Wisconsin continue to grow. From bringing innovative diagnostic and treatment options for our hospital and clinic patients to expanding the number of communities we serve, 2007 again was an impressive year for the north region.

Here are the highlights:

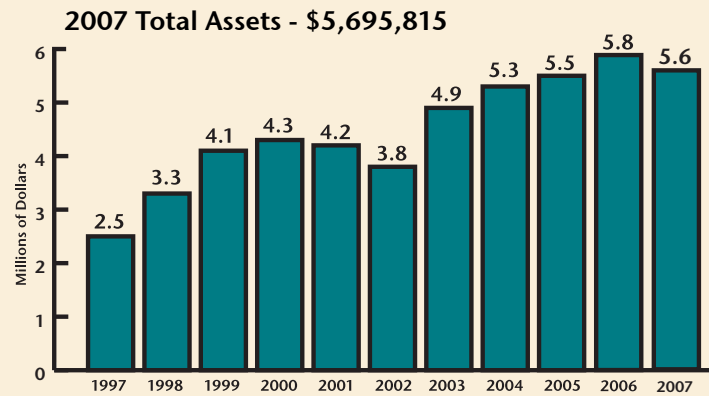
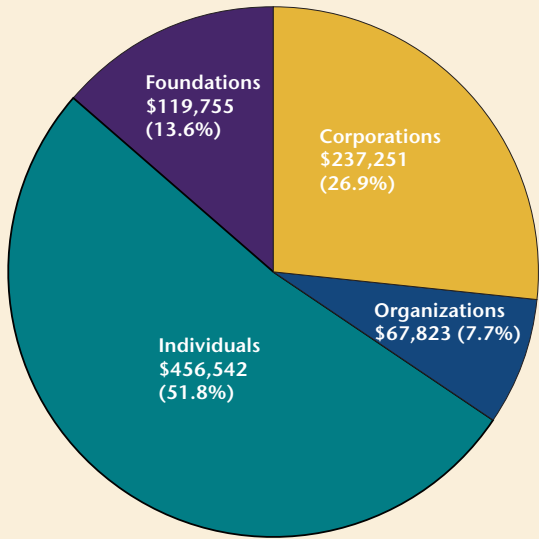
- In June, Aurora Health Care was recognized for setting the standard for health care quality in Wisconsin and the nation. The Premier Healthcare Alliance, a national alliance of 1,700 not-for-profit hospitals and health systems, recognized Aurora with eight 2007 Premier Awards for Quality for excellence in the care of patients. Included in Aurora's eight awards – the most one health system has ever achieved in one year – was one for heart failure care at Aurora BayCare Medical Center in Green Bay. The eight awards are among 49 quality awards presented by Premier to hospitals and health systems across the country. The announcement of the awards followed the release of a new report by the federal Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality showing that Wisconsin ranks first among the states for health care quality.
- Four communities welcomed Aurora Health Care with the addition of new Aurora Health Centers. These primary care centers, which provide basic diagnostic and treatment options including x-ray and lab work, enable people living and working in Denmark (January), Bonduel (April), Clintonville (July) and Suamico (September) to have access to our services where they need them most.
- In February, a new Aurora Health Center opened in Valders, replacing the existing clinic with an updated facility offering more expanded services and advanced equipment.
- Aurora BayCare Medical Center in Green Bay helped a local woman become the first in the state to receive a new breast cancer treatment that conserves the breast while limiting damage to nearby healthy tissue. The technology, known as SAVI™, is a radiation applicator that is able to target designated areas with its expandable bundle of catheters. It carries the same benefits of other partial breast irradiation approaches that are known for reducing treatments to just one week, but also can fit into different cavity shapes, sizes and locations.
- In November, Aurora BayCare Medical Center was re-verified as a Level II trauma center by the Committee on Trauma of the American College of Surgeons. This achievement recognizes Aurora BayCare's dedication to providing optimal care for injured patients. Aurora BayCare first received Level II trauma verification in 2002. The recent verification will be reviewed again in 2010.
- In August, Aurora Medical Center in Two Rivers was named one of the nation's top performance improvement leader hospitals by Thomson Healthcare, the leading provider of decision support solutions that help organizations across the health care industry improve clinical and business performance. The Manitowoc County hospital and its senior management team were recognized for being one of 100 hospitals making the greatest progress in improving hospital-wide performance over five consecutive years (2001-2005).
